Joy is also a volunteer with **Virtual War Memorial Australia** <https://vwma.org.au/> recording War Memorials, Honour Rolls, War Cemeteries from all around Australia as most are disappearing or being vandalised. When you go into the site, there is oodles of info for anyone researching their military history. In the search field in the right top hand corner just type in the name of the place you are interested in and it will bring up everything that has been done for that area, i.e. Joy has completed the Busselton and surrounding areas.

While Irish migration to America is universally acknowledged, the most likely destination for Irish emigrants was Britain. In Australia, also, around a third of the population claim Irish heritage.

----- SOCIAL RECORDS -----

In addition to over 850,000 Irish records, a new record set featuring women who were working at the Vickers shipyard in Barrow-in-Furness, Lancashire during World War 1 is available. This could provide **additional insight into the changing lives of women** especially if accessed along with the 1921 Census add-on subscription.

You will also find social records from across the globe, from the dark legacy of British slavery in 1883 providing details of colonial enslavers, to the details of commemorative plaques across the UK.

Four new record sets from the Nottinghamshire Diocesan Archives who cover Nottinghamshire, Derbyshire, Rutland, Leicestershire and Lincolnshire. The earliest addition is a 1641 baptism records rolling until 1931, all with images.
